

[The story of the 2020 Red Hoffman Cup Matches follows, based heavily on the content presented during the event on www.hoffmancup.org. The article below covers the Finals, then jumps to a chronological description of what happened in the 2020 Matches leading up to the Final. Team vs team results are listed in the Appendix.]

The 2020 Hoffman Cup: Hamilton Farm Brings It Home!

The four 2020 Red Hoffman Cup finalists met at beautiful Hamilton Farm Golf Club on October 18, and a squad that seemed to be on a mission the whole season took home the Red Hoffman Cup for the first time.

Playing its home track, Hamilton Farm wrested the title from three-time defender Arcola Country Club by merely one shot (280 to 281) to mark a meteoric rise to the top of the competition

The Hoffman Cup Finals was the culmination of a covid-influenced, season-long interclub competition that started 2020 with 36 clubs. By the time Finals Sunday came along, only four teams were left standing after several matches apiece: Arcola, the odds-on favorite based on four championships in the last five years; Hamilton Farm, which made the playoffs this year for the first time since 2011, but who had some new faces and a new strategy to win; Manasquan River Golf Club, which has always been in the Hoffman Cup's top tier of teams; and Montclair Golf Club, which came to the Finals with the clear intent to win it all – something it has done five times already.

The format was 18 holes of medal-play, two-man better-ball sides, no handicaps. Each club was represented by four sides and all four scores would count on the lush, visually stunning par-72, 6850-yard Hamilton Farm layout.

The finals looked to some observers all afternoon long like the prelude to a sudden-death playoff, but Hamilton Farm won the day behind the sterling play of two sides that carded a four-under par 68, the low score in this better-ball competition. One 68 was almost expected – the side of Hoffman Cup captain Drew Jordan and teammate Mark Costanza, the 2020 New Jersey Open champion, seemed almost disappointed with its total. However, it was the 68 by their much less-heralded Hamilton Farm teammates Ira Flood and Erik Stevens that excited the home club gallery. Rounding out Hamilton Farm's scoring, the side of Eric Davis and Zach Koerbel turned in a steady 71 followed by Jackson Kramer and Chester Patterson teaming for a 73. It was a balanced team effort that took home the Hoffman Cup at eight under par.

At the last putt, defending champion club Arcola was one stroke shy. Losing by one shot is never easy, but Arcola can take solace in the idea that they defended with a balanced, collective grace. The side of Lucas Farmer / Trevor Randolph led Arcola's scoring with 69, followed by Ryan Chin / Grant Sturgeon's hard-fought 70, which tied teammates Brendan Jonland / Chris DeJohn. An even-par 72 by the side of Brian Celiberti / Michael O'Connell completed the seven-under 281 total.

Montclair, which won an impressive five consecutive Hoffman Cup titles in the competition's first decade, made a commitment this year to win the Cup again. Its high-spirited, (mostly) young team seemed ready to follow new Captain Rob Scalzo's direction, and the squad nearly pulled it off. With three sides shooting 72 (Tyler Galantini / Max Sorger, A.J. Karanikolas / John Kovacs and Kevin Pfeffer / Ty Zebrowski) and the fourth (Alex Smith / Jeff Maines) shooting 73, they needed a little *less* balance and maybe a 64 to be part of the title conversation. The fact that

several of their fellow members made the trip to Hamilton Farm to be part of the gallery added an extra zest to the proceedings. Look out for Montclair in 2021.

Manasquan River, led by Captain Chris Dymek, is always in the mix, it seems, capturing a spot in the Finals seemingly every other year. This year's team was a dangerous combination of youth and experience, with the talented young Wall brothers, Ethan and Jerry, combining for a squad-low 70. The Old Guard was represented by Chris Farren and Chris Housen at (73). The side of Richard Fitzsimmons / Andrew Kelly shot 76, while Captain Dymek and veteran Tom Hassel shot an uncharacteristic 78. Manasquan River's 297 total will only whet its appetite to make the Finals again next year.

Hamilton Farm was a wonderful host, with its only blemish not allowing one of their guests to take the Cup. With a memorable view seemingly in every direction, the course provides great elevations, wide fairways, heaving greens and memorable bunkering, all in pristine condition. The clubhouse, which dates back over 100 years, and grounds are similarly breathtaking, evoking an earlier era with every turn on its mile-long driveway.

2020 Hoffman Cup Intragroup Play

The 2020 Hoffman Cup's normal early spring play with 36 clubs was thrown out the window by the Covid-19 pandemic. Flexibility was required as some clubs, understandably, felt they would not be able to participate at all. Reflecting this less-than-full participation, clubs were divided into eight four or five-club groups. Intragroup play in 2020 started in early July and commenced through September. Also, scheduling was left to the team captains to complete.

The 2020 Hoffman Cup Semis – Only One Newbie

The heart and soul of the Hoffman Cup Matches – the intragroup matches – were in the books, and only eight teams survived. By the time the semifinals concluded, only one club advanced out of the semis that didn't have considerable Finals experience – Hamilton Farm GC put the hammer to an impressive Ridgewood CC squad.

The other three semis could not have been much closer. Manasquan River GC upset perennial contender, Baltusrol GC, by the closest of margins, Fairmount CC saw its reentry into the winner's circle just stymied by a

Montclair GC birdie barrage, and defender Arcola CC squeaked by Black Oak GC by one well-timed putt.
